When launching the game you see the start screen where you can choose to be a boy or a girl. When that choice is made you see an introduction screen which elaborates how you are a few weeks away from your final exam for your degree. The choices you make will affect the future and you should choose them wisely.

Girl route:

The girl route starts with an alarm clock signal, here you only have the choice to wake up to start the game.

The next scene shows a fragment of the alarm clock which shows the time. You get the description that it is time for school

Option 1) Go to school Option 2) Stay at home

When you choose to stay at home you will receive an invitation on your phone (this will be elaborated later in the description)

When you choose to go to school you get a fragment of you walking in the VU. Next you will hear your stomach rumbling. You will see the description that you are hungry and you get two choices

- 1) Go to class
- 2) Eat something first

If you go to class you will see a fragment of you walking in the canteen. Afterwards you will have a scene where you sit at a table in the canteen and you get the description "You just ate, are you going back to class?". This leads to 2 choices

- 1) No, i don't feel like going
- 2) Go back to class

The first choice will also lead to the invitation on your phone you would have got when you stayed at home (this invitation will be elaborated later in the description) The second choice will lead to the same fragment you would have got when you immediately went to class when you arrived at school, instead of going to the canteen first. This fragment

shows you walking to class and later the description "Wow, you actually went to class" appears. When you press the "next" button, the invitation appears. So it does not matter what you choose, you will eventually always get the invitation.

The invitation shows a message of someone asking you if you want to hang out. Here you have 3 choices

- 1) yes
- 2) No, you'd rather stay home to read
- 3) No, you should study

When the choices 2 or 2 are made, you arrive at a scene where you see yourself reading or studying, and then the next day starts.

When choice 1 is made, you will get a fragment where you are at a party and after a while the description "It is getting late appears". The player then gets 2 choices

- 1) Eat some pizza
- 2) Go home to study.

When the second choice is made, you will see a fragment of you studying and afterwards the next day starts.

When you make the 1 first choice, you arrive at a fragment where are eating pizza with friends. The description "You have to wake up early tomorrow to study" appears. The 2 choices you will see are:

- 1) Go to a club
- 2) Go home

When the second choice is made, you will go to the next day. The first choice leads to a fragment of people in a club. After you press the "next" button you will also go to the next day.

The next fragment again shows the alarm clock, this time with the description "Your test is tomorrow!"

The player gets 2 choices

- 1) Study all day
- 2) Read all day
- 3) Watch netflix all day

All three choices will lead to a fragment showing the choice you made. After this last choice you will arrive at the crossroad. You are walking through your street and you see the following text: "You are going to your test. You hope you've made the right choices." The next button will show a scene where you either have passed the test, failed the test or have dropped out to pursue your hobby. This depends on the choices you have made and the scores you've end up with. After pressing the "next" button for one last time, you return to the introduction screen.

Guy route:

The game starts with you waking up and walking to your computer. There you get 3 choices

- 1) Read a book
- 2) Study
- 3) Check phone

The first 2 choices lead to a fragment of you reading or studying. Afterwards another fragment of you sitting in front of your computer screen appears, now with the following choices:

- 1) Lets draw
- 2) Lets study

Again, the choices lead to a fragment of you doing either of these things, after pressing the "skip" button, the next day starts"

If you chose to check your phone in the first segment, the invitation to hang out with your friends appears. You get 2 choices

- 1) Chill
- 2) Study

If you choose to study you see a fragment of yourself studying and afterwards you go to the fragment with the choices previously stated, where you can either study or draw. If you chose to chill, a scene of you hanging out with your friends appears. After a while, the text "It's getting late, maybe I should go home... or should I stay?" appears. The player gets two choices

- 1) Lets stay
- 2) I should go home

When you choose to go home, the next day starts

If you choose to stay, you continue drinking with your friends, you stay out late and eventually get attacked on the street. The next scene shows you waking up on the street, after you woke up you go home and the next day starts.

You wake up again and go back to your desk. Arrived at your desk the following choices appear:

- 1) Play game
- 2) Lecture
- 3) Draw

Each choice leads to a fragment of either you playing a game, going to the VU and attending a lecture of a fragment of you drawing. When the fragment is finished, the day before the exam starts.

The player has 3 choices:

- 1) House party
- 2) Art gallery
- 3) Study hard

Again, depending on your choice you see fragments of either you studying hard, visiting an art gallery or attending a house party. After the fragments have ended you reach the crossroad. You see yourself riding your bike and the following text appears: "You have taken the exam and you hope you've made the right choices.

Then the ending appears, the ending is either a fragment of you becoming successful because you passed the test and graduated, you deciding to drop out of school and become an artist or you becoming unmotivated and jobless. This depends on the choices you have made and the scores you ended up with. When you press the "next" button, you return to the introduction screen.
